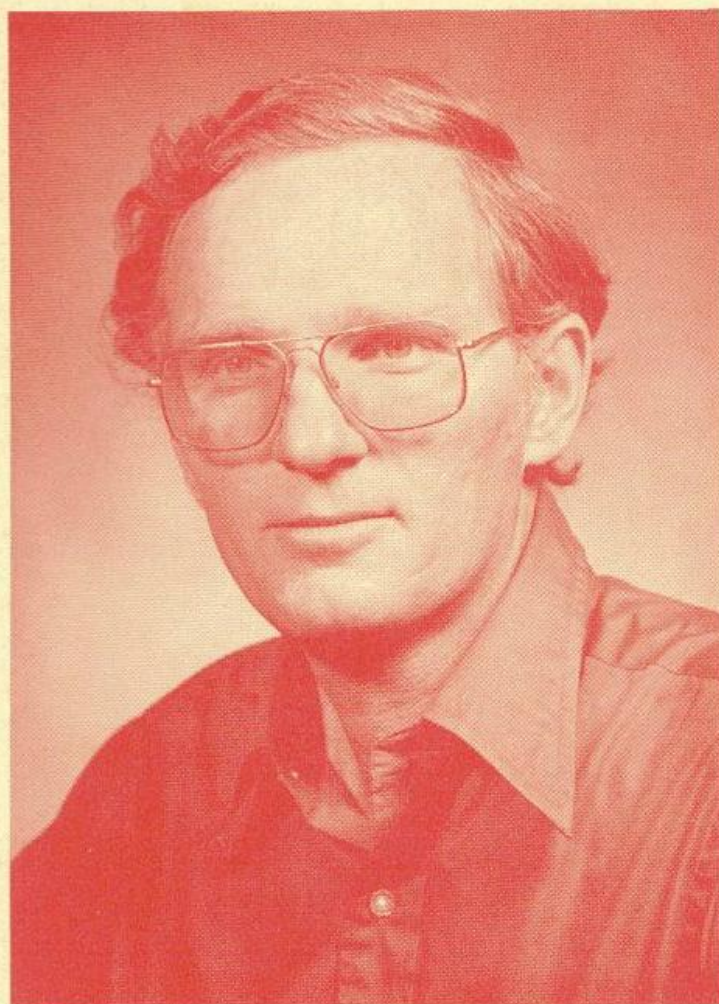


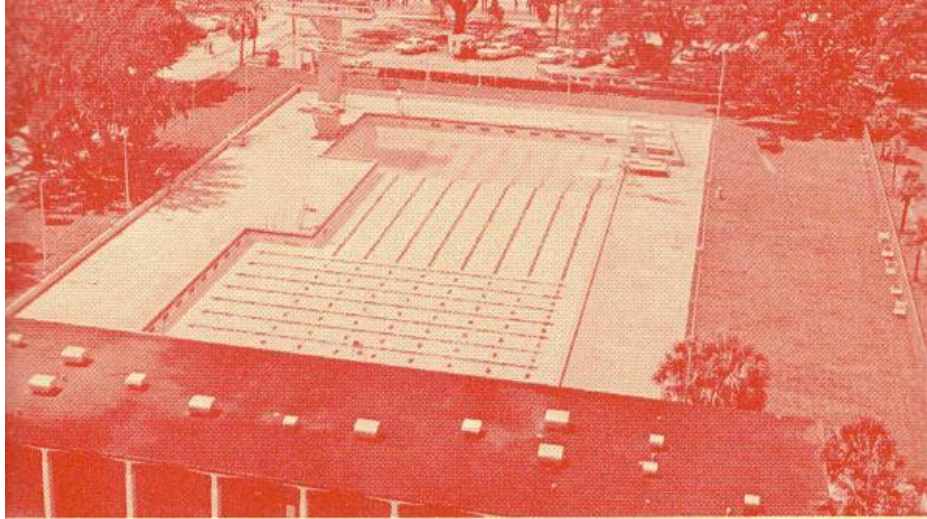

## UNION POOL

The mild climate of the Tallahassee winter allows the Seminole program to work outside all year in Union Pool on the Florida State campus.

The standard 25-yard "collegiate course" has eight lanes set into a 60' wide area. This leaves each of the outside lanes two feet from the wall, making them as fast as the middle lanes. The same is true for the eight lane, 50-meter course.

The diving area meets or exceeds all the latest published specifications as outlined by the NCAA and the AAU. Included in the diving area are a pair of one meter and two three-meter boards and a platform tower. All four Duraflex boards are mounted on Durafirm fulcrums. The tower has platforms at five, seven and one-half and 10 meters.

Adjacent to the pool area is a "porta pit" complex for "dry diving." It includes a Duraflex Board on a moveable fulcrum.

Dressing facilities at the pool are available for varsity swimmers, as well as men and women's visiting teams. Additional facilities for championship meets are also available.

Timing and judging for all union pool meets is handled by the Kyroscope electronic timer which registers time to thousandths (.000) for six lanes.

## OUTLOOK

New Head Coach Terry Carlisle has termed the 1973-74 swimming outlook at Florida State as a "building year." Last year the Seminoles compiled a 5-5 record in Bim Stults 25th, and final season as head coach at Florida State.

Although half the squad is made up of freshmen and sophomores, Coach Carlisle believes the young Seminoles could surprise some people. Many of the young swimmers have gained experience through AAU and strong high school competition, and should have little difficulty adjusting to collegiate meets.

The strength in this year's squad is in its depth. The Seminoles are not notably weak in any area, and should be in contention in every meet. Another asset, is the tremendous morale they have exhibited through the early workouts.

Coach Carlisle's main emphasis will be to, "get as many people qualified for the Nationals as possible." He hopes to have his swimmers reach their peak at the National Independent Championships, where they may qualify for the NCAA Championships in Long Beach, California.

Four Seniors return for their final year of competition, including John Hegert and Larry Shoeman, who qualified for the Nationals last year.

Hegert qualified in the 200 yard freestyle. Shoeman, a diver qualified, but failed to make the trip to the nationals.

The other two seniors expected to make strong contributions are Jeff Selvey (Freestyle, Breaststroke) and Alan Stephenson (Freestyle).

Three juniors who will be expected to contribute a great deal also are Robert McKay, Matt Mosteller, and Arthur Reaume.

McKay returns stronger and faster than ever after a vigorous summer training program. Mosteller, a versatile swimmer with added maturity, is a real asset to the squad. These two, paired with Reaume, an excellent breaststroke swimmer, give the young Seminoles much needed added experience and maturity.

With only seven upper classmen, the Seminoles will be relying heavily on talented sophomores and freshmen for depth. Of the sophomores, Cliff Schlak, Gene Eakens, and Jeff Bauer, all showed great potential last year, and should be ready to move into their own.

The coaches feel freshman Steve Rosenbaum and Paul Wise are ready for varsity competition, and should be among the team's top competitors.

## THE SEMINOLE SWIMMING PROGRAM

For the first time in 25 years, Florida State will have a new Head Coach, Terry Carlisle. Bim Stults, the only swimming coach Florida State has known, retired last year leaving an impressive 185-48-2 record behind. Only twice in that period did the Seminoles finish with a losing season.

In the Seminoles' history, only six times have they lost as many as three meets in a single year. New mentor Carlisle looks forward to the opportunity of keeping the Seminoles' winning tradition intact.

Coach Carlisle brings with him two personal goals to accomplish at Florida State. First, he would like to bring an NCAA Championship to Florida State. Second, he hopes to break every school record. Coach Carlisle believes with the program continuing to grow, and the great facilities available, these ambitions are within reach.

The Seminoles boast nearly two dozen All-Americans of past years in swimming and diving. Included are a pair of National Championship awards, one earned by Curt Genders in one-meter diving in 1969, and the other by Phil Boggs in three-meter diving in 1971.

The winning tradition is just one part of Florida State's success story. Many former Seminoles have gone on to become outstanding coaches in both high school and college. It's believed that more F.S.U. graduates are now coaching, than from any school in the country.

Coach Carlisle previously was an assistant coach at the University of Tennessee, where he received his Masters Degree in Educational Administration. He received his undergraduate degree at Yale, where he lettered in swimming.

Assisting Coach Carlisle this season will be three former collegiate stars.

John Rangeley rejoins the Seminoles after seven successful years as head coach at Sarasota High School. In that time he had four undefeated seasons at Sarasota High. This is nothing new to the Chattanooga, Tenn. native, who was a member of the F.S.U. squad that went undefeated in 1964 and 1965.

Serving in his first year with the Seminoles is former All-American John Rubottom. The Bethesda, Md. native comes to Florida State from SMU where he led the Mustangs to the Southwest Conference Championship.

Richard Matheny, an All-American diver from Ohio State also joins the Seminole staff for the first time. A native of Detroit, Michigan Richard earned All-America honors in the three meter diving competition last year, along with being named a scholar athlete.
