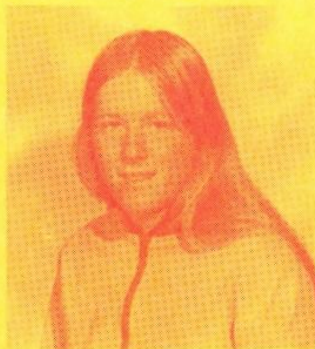

In the third year at FSU Reynaud's teams have won the state tournament the past two years and won regionals in 1978. She graduated from Southwest Missouri State University in 1975 after playing field hockey and volleyball for four years. Her college volleyball team was ranked in the top eight nationally. Reynaud was named an Outstanding College Athlete in America two years while in school.

Her teaching experiences have been at the junior high and high school level in Missouri while also coaching basketball, softball, track, and volleyball.

The past four summers have been spent conducting volleyball clinics and camps for coaches, teachers, and athletes in Alabama, Florida, Kansas, Louisiana, Missouri, North Carolina, and South Carolina.

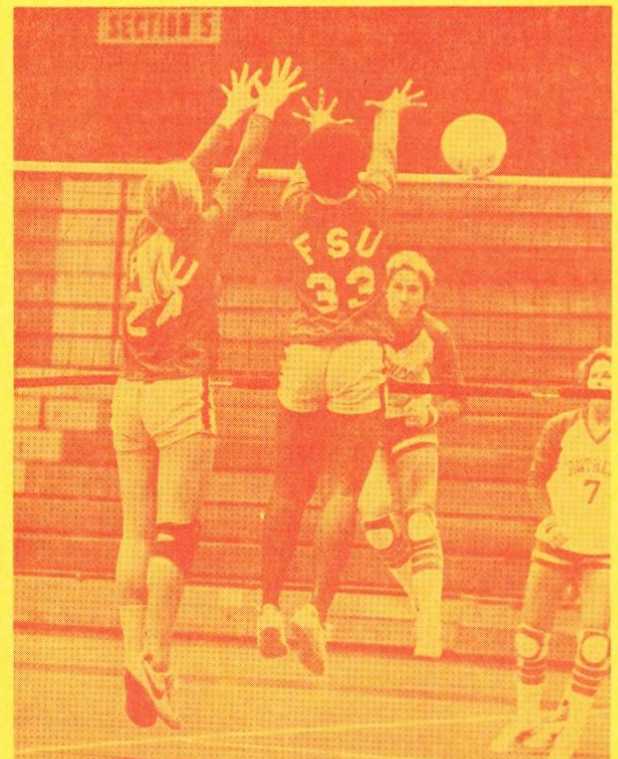
OUTLOOK

The best thing about the Volleyball program at FSU is the strong support of the rapidly growing Women's Athletic Department. We are providing a year round training program here at FSU. We feel this is necessary to get the experience and skill level needed to be competitive in the nation. The college season begins in August and continues into December. In January we join the USVBA organization in our region and compete in six to eight tournaments throughout the state. During the summer our Beach Volleyball Association provides tournaments on both coasts with doubles play being the main attraction.

We are competing out of our region this year and plan more of these trips in the future for better competition!

Our 1978 season record before attending the National AIAW Large College Volleyball tournament was 28-9. The FSU team went through the state and regional tournament undefeated winning their last eleven matches.

The trip to Southwest Missouri proved to be very enlightening for the Lady Seminoles beating such teams as Illinois State, Texas A&M, and the Univ. of Cincinnati. In January, the Lady Seminoles traveled to Jamaica for a week tour of the islands. During the trip, the team was undefeated in their matches with Jamaican teams.
