## AFTER ACCIDENT

## Shaken FSU Bows, 78-61

MIAMI, Jan. 9. (AP)—Miami's Hurricanes sped to a 78-61 victory tonight over a Florida State University basketball team that showed the effects of an automobile accident yesterday in which several players were shaken up.

Four of the players involved in the accident started the game but two, Jerry Westhafer and Rick Benson, played only briefly and neither scored a point.

Ham Wernke, ordinarily a high scorer, was held to 10 points and Tom Burst, who also was in the accident, accounted for only one field goal.

A station wagon carrying members of the FSU squad turned over near Bradenton while en route to Miami for the game. There were no serious injuries but five players. Coach Bud Ken-

nedy and trainer Fred Hoover required hospital treatment for cuts and bruises.

Miami played its best game of the season in the first half, running up a 43-21 margin. Willie Schayowitz scored three baskets in a row in the first two minutes to send the Hurricanes away to a 6-1 lead and the margin mounted to 16-3 as Schayowitz hit three more from the field. Dominating play on the floor and controlling the rebounds, Miami held the Seminoles to three baskets in the first quarter.

In the second period, the Seminoles began to hit from the free throw line but the Hurricanes, led by Dick Miani and Harold Arterbkrn, added to their lead.

The victory, before 1,200 fans, broke a four-game Miami losing streak.
