CHARLOTTE, N.C. (AP)—Clemson pulled away early in the second half and went on to smother Florida State, 94-76, yesterday to join Tennessee in the championship semifinals of the inaugural Carrousel basketball classic.

Clemson and Tennessee, 80-77, winner over Boston University, whose 6-8 center Kevin Thomas scored 46 points, will meet at 3:30 p.m. tomorrow following a consolation game between Boston and Florida State.

Colgate's speedy sharpshooters buried Davidson 86-51 in another first round game. Wake Forest beat Mississippi, 95-68, in the fourth contest.

The score was tied 5 times in the early going before Clemson went ahead of Florida State for keeps at 11-10. It was 45-41 at the half and Clemson quickly ran up a 61-47 lead when play resumed. Soph forward Vince Yockel sparked the last half for Clemson with 18 of his 23 points, and guard Bill Yarborough finished as high man with 25 for

the winning Tigers, 18 in the first half.

Stubby guard Jim Oler threw in 37 points for Florida State, 23 in the first half.

Tennessee got a 30-point effort from forward Carl Widseth as it handed Boston its first loss in five starts in a game that saw the score tied 12 times, six in each half.
