CHARLESTON, S. C.—Miami's Hurricanes used a red-hot combination of a huge center and a tiny guard to turn back Florida State's Seminoles, 85-79, in the opening game of The Citadel Invitational tournament here last night.

Georgia's Bulldogs hit a stone wall in The Citadel defense and lost, 78-52, to the host team in the second game.

Miami and The Citadel battle for the tourney championship tonight after Florida State and Georgia scrap for consolation honors.

DROVE THROUGH

The smallest man in the tournament, 5-6 sophomore guard Dick Hickox, sparked Miami to its six-point decision over the Seminoles. The stubby backcourt ace drove through and around the Seminoles for 20 points.

But Harry Manushaw, a 5-8 sophomore giant from Gary Ind./ was almost as valuable for the Hurricanes. Manushaw collared 27 rebounds, only five short of The Citadel court record of 32, and contributed 15 points.

Even with those fine showings free throws spelled the difference. Normally a hot-shooting free throw team, the Seminoles managed only 17 of 34 charity attempts while Mismi canned 31 of 36. FSU outscored Mismi from the field, 31-27
