The Tribe beat Miami decisively on the boards as Dan Boltz, 6-8 senior center, pulled down 23 rebounds, an FSU stason high. Aided tremendously by this big individual effort, the Seminoles outrebounded UM, 72 to 47.

Once again, guards Hugh Durham and Don Bates were a deadly scoring pair. Durham, averaging better than 23 points per game, got 29 in this one. Bates' fadeaway shots were elicking smooth? and he totaled 25.

Playing its third game in as many north Florida nights, Miami appeared a bit road-weary. The Seminoles out-ran the visitors all evening.

Though Miami didn't but a field goal until the game was 5:30 old, it mainted to stay close for awhile.

Ahead 13-11, the Seminal's started their race, extended things to 25-13 before Miami got

another point.

It was 39-23 at halftime, Midway the last half, PSU held its biggest lead, 73-45.
