

Hugh Durham, one of Florida State's all-time basketball greats, has won the Seminoles' individual scoring championship for the second time in three years.

Final 23-game statistics reveal Durham finished his last season of a three-year varsity career with 501 points and a 21.9 average. The 5-11 guard from Louisville, Ky., has earned honorable mention on United Press International's all-America team and a first-team spot on the All-Florida college basketball squad for the third straight year.

An excellent student who is a member of "Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities," Durham scored 1,381 points (18.9 average) in 73 games as a Seminole. He set FSU's single-game scoring record with 43 points against Stetson in 1956.

This season, Durham bagged 30 or more points in 15 of Florida State's 26 games. The Semi-

nole team captain was best against Southeastern Conference teams, averaging 25.6 points in seven starts against SEC fives.

Durham's season highs were 36 against Georgia, 31 against LSU and 30 against defending NCAA champion Kentucky. Twice he collected 26 points against Auburn.

Runner-up to Durham was junior guard Don Bates of Jasper, Ind. Bates scored 434 points for an 18.9 average. Together, the backcourt pair accounted for 53

per cent (938) of FSU's 1,770 points.

Bates led in field goals with 179, nine more than Durham. But Durham cashed in 162 free throws to runner-up Bates' 76. Senior center Dan Bolts of Quincy, Ill., pulled down 264 rebounds to lead in that category.

Playing their toughest schedule ever, Coach Bud Kennedy's Seminoles finished with an 8-15 record.
