



Ed Badger - Cincinnati

We are very happy with the outcome. Joe Williams and I met seven or eight times and it has always been a one or a two or a three point game and this one was certainly no different. We felt rebounding would be the key. We stayed in a tight zone defense, the idea being if they were going to beat us it was going to have to be from the outside. It was to our advantage that it was a low scoring game. We didn't want it to get up into the eighties.

We missed some key free throws near the end. And I almost had a heart attack when we threw an inbounds pass to a Florida State player underneath the basket. We never do anything easy at Cincinnati. We won 16 now. At Christmas we were 3 and 5 and had come off a big loss to Virginia Commonwealth. If anyone had said then that we would have won 16 games, I would have bet them.

Florida State is a strong team. They are hard to handle inside. I think we won the game because we took a minimum of real poor shots.

Joe Williams -- Florida State

"In the beginning of the game it seemed as though the ball didn't want to bounce the right way. We made some great defensive plays but they got 13 offensive rebounds in the first half and five baskets on stick-backs.

"We made several runs at them in the second half but everytime we had a chance to go up by three we just weren't in quite enough control. We got the lead by going inside to Elvis and Kris but then we stopped doing that for some reason.

"Cincinnati made their free throws and we had a couple of chances to win the game but Cincinnati played smart basketball and they played hard.

"We didn't want to foul Kennedy, Johonson or Austin, but they were the ones that handled the ball and we didn't have a choice. We thought it was better to foul Johnson than Kennedy.

Player Quotes - Cincinnati

Doc Holden - Before every game this year Coach Badger would tell us the rebounding would be the key to the game and it was the same here tonight. Their whole team is bigger than we are. We knew that Anderson would be the key. They didn't have him when we played them down there (at Florida State). We knew we had to stop Rolle and Anderson on the board.

Dwight Jones - It's hard to block out big men because they shove alot and the referee can miss alot inside. It seemed in the second half that they let them get away with a lot of pushing. You expect that when you play against bigger people because they take up so much space. We still shouldn't have let them get as many rebounds as they got in the second half.
