

Seminoles Win Quick Tilt, 6, 2

The Florida State University Seminoles struck for two runs in the last of the seventh inning to break a 2-2 tie and then added another brace of markers in the eighth to defeat the Mississippi College Choctaws 6 to 2 in a Dixie Conference baseball game here yesterday afternoon.

The victory was seventh of the season in eight starts for the Seminoles, and their fourth conference win without a defeat.

Bob Hartman went all the way on the mound for the Seminoles to register his second triumph of the year without a loss. Hartman walked one man and struck out five as he held the Choctaws hitless and runless except for the fourth frame when they bunched four singles for two runs.

TRIPLE TROUBLE

Successive triples by Glen Gresham and Bob Trowbridge after two men were out last of the seventh inning broke up the ball game which was tied 2-2 at that time. Gresham's hugged the left field foul line and Trow-

bridge's went in the hole between left and center to score Gresham. Trowbridge himself tallied a moment later when Augie Pompelia singled.

The contest was the most interesting and fastest of the season here, being completed in one hour and 38 minutes.

Florida State opened the scoring in the first inning when Lee Bailey was hit by a pitched ball, went to second when Hunter boot-ed Gresham's grounder, and to third as Gresham and Trowbridge were erased on a neat double play. Then with the count two balls and one strike on Pompelia, Bailey stole home.

Two more Choctaw errors, a base on balls and a single by Les Mullens got another run for the Seminoles in the second inning, but this lead was short lived as Mississippi College tied things up top of the fourth frame. A quick double play, Pompelia to Bailey to Ken Smith, finally halted the Choctaw rally.

Florida State's insurance markers in the eighth inning came on Smith's third walk of the day, singles by Spike Herald and Bailey, a Mississippi College error and a passed ball.

The Florida State baseball team goes on the road this week for games with Rollins College at Winter Park Friday and Saturday.
