Seminole Nine Tops Davidson

Long Registers Third Triumph

Florida State teed off on two Davidson pitchers for 13 hits, including four doubles and a triple, to grab an easy 7-1 victory at their East Campus diamond yesterday.

The Seminoles, who left 13 runners stranded on the bases, coasted behind the pitching of sophomore Max Long. Long gave up eight hits on the way to his third straight victory. The Jacksonville right-hander, who had gone the distance all three times, chipped in with a double and a single and scored two runs.

FSU will try to make it two wins in a row this afternoon, when they host Alabama State Teachers College of Jacksonville. Senior Forrest Brown is Coach Ralph Matherly's choice to open on the mound in the 3 p.m. game.

Three other Seminoles collected two hits yesterday. They were centerfielder Bob Hudson, second - sacker Billy Campbell, and third baseman Carlee Hendrix. FSU first baseman Fred Twomey suffered a big letdown in the first inning. A freshman from Gloucester, Mass., Twomey clouted an apparent three-run homer over the 340-foot left field fence, only to be ruled out by plate Umpire Walt Schenk. Schenk said that Twomey's back foot was out of the batter's box when he swung at a 3-2 pltch.

The Seminoles played errorless ball behind Long, handling 39 chances without a bobble.
