

Florida State baseballers pounded Jacksonville (Ala.) State Teachers, 24-0, here yesterday afternoon, backing two-hit pitching by Forrest Brown and Bobby Waites with a 12-hit assault in a game shorted to six and one-half innings by agreement.

The 24 runs established a single game scoring record for the Seminoles.

Ten walks, three wild pitches, three passed balls and 14 errors contributed to the big score.

QUICK JUMP

The Seminoles wasted no time, jumping to a 3-0 lead in the

first inning. Glayden Schafer doubled. Billy Campbell and Tom Moore lived on errors, with Schafer scoring. After two outs, Fred Twemey rapped a double that scored Mills and Moore.

FSU got three more in the second on singles by Schafer, Campbell and Moore, coupled with some alert base-running and a Teachers error.

Five runs in the third moved the sticks to 11-0. The Seminoles got only two hits in the frame, singles by Moore and Brown, but errors and a walk paved the way.

A walk, an error and Bob Wynn's single brought a lone run in the fourth.

WILD INNING

Five Seminoles crossed the plate in the fifth. Schafer and Mills singled. Three wild pitches, three passed balls, four walks and two errors did the rest.

FSU erupted for seven runs in the sixth. Four more errors, three walks, a single by Campbell and Bobby Waites' two-run triple were the features.

Schafer's three hits led the Seminoles at bat.

FSU's next game is with the Tallahassee Rebels tomorrow night in Centennial Field. Ralph Math-erly's men have scheduled a workout under lights at the field tonight.
