Florida State's baseball team, limited to four hits and one run for six innings, paraded seven runs across the plate in the eighth inning to complete a series sweep from the Amherst College Lord Jeffs, 10-6, here yesterday.

It was FSU's eighth win against three losses and gives the Seminoles a 6-1 record against collegiate teams.

The Seminoles, who routed Amherst, 11-3. Monday, were trailing by 6-3 hefore their eighth-inning outburst, which tied their best previous inning in the way of run production. Five hits, singles by Hilly Campbell, Bob Hudson, Bob Bondi and Bobby Waits and a triple by Cooler Mills, coupled with three walks, accounted for the seven runs.

The Seminoles had to overcome a six-run margin Amherst had stacked up off starter Ham Wernke over the first five innings. George Hehemann, who pitched three acoreless innings, and Jim Atwood, who worked the ninth, also pitched for FSU, with Hehemann getting his first 1954 win against no setbacks.

shortstop Mills, the Seminoles' leading hitter among the regulars with a robust 415 average (17 hits in 41 at-bats), was the plate star yesterday. Cooter lined two sharp singles to left before unloading a two-run triple to the left-centerfield wall in that seven-run rally.
