

Florida State's ambitious baseball team, away to a successful start, was scheduled to go after its second victory over Auburn here this afternoon, 3:30. Yesterday the Seminoles opened their season with an 8-2 conquest of the Tigers here.

Jack Bristol, a junior out of Sharon, Conn., was due to pitch for FSU. Auburn did not announce its probable pitcher.

BIG INNING

A four-run third inning featured the Seminoles' victory yesterday.

Auburn's Wynton Overstreet and the Tribe's Fred Kenney had duelled scorelessly up to that point. Four singles and a sacrifice sandwiched around two costly Auburn errors netted the four.

A single by first baseman Fred Twomey brought in two. Errors by third baseman Jack Crouch and leftfielder L. R. Lanier let in two others.

Phil Hunt's single, John Shepard's walk and a sacrifice by Kenney set the stage for Overton's departure to the showers in the fourth. Another error by Crouch on Kenney's bunt had filled the bases.

ONE ACROSS

Owen McCarron greeted reliever Bill Cawthorne with a run-scoring single and the Seminoles led 5-0. Cawthorne set down Charles Hendrix and Dick Howser to retire the side after that.

Auburn broke the ice in the fifth with a triple by Jack Bur-

kett and a single by leadoff man Bob James, then added a final tally in the seventh, with James again driving it in, this time with a sacrifice fly following a walk to Pat Duke and a single by Cawthorne.

Two more Tiger errors helped the Seminoles push across three unearned runs in the bottom of the seventh to wrap up the contest.

After Howser walked, Twomey beat out an infield hit and a bad throw by Auburn short stop Bill Roberson allowed Howser to score and Twomey to move to third.

A sacrifice fly by Lee Corae scored Twomey, and a double by Bob Rosell, a passed ball and another error by Crouch—his third of the game—let Rosell score.

Twomey, Hunt and McCarron all contributed a pair of hits for the winners, while Crouch collected two for the visitors.
