Dull, Tallahassee sophomore shortstop, drove in three runs and set a new school record of 30 runs batted in. He eclipsed the old mark of 27 RBI's set by All-American shortstop Dick Howser.

Dull collected his three RBIs when he singled in two runs in the first inning and doubled home one more in the seventh.
