

Florida State's eager baseball team drilled out 12 hits, five of them for extra bases, to turn back Auburn, 11-4, in the rubber game of a three-game series here yesterday.

Coch Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles scored eight runs in the fifth and sixth innings to hit double figures in the run column for the fourth time in seven games this season.

#### HIGH AVERAGE

Now 5-2, the Tribe has scored 70 runs for an average of 10 runs a game. Even more impressive is the Seminole team batting mark. The Seminoles have 82 hits in 252 plate appearances for a .325 team batting average.

Third baseman Jack Dull of Tallahassee paced yesterday's attack with a triple and two singles. Centerfielder Bob Clem bagged two doubles and team captain Ray Hamrell kept his average at .500 with a double and single.

Sophomore southpaw Ray McShane picked up his first varsity victory, taming the Tigers on two runs and three hits over seven innings.

#### STARTER HIT

Auburn starter Jim Boyd was tagged with all 12 hits and 11 runs before retiring in the seventh inning. Shortstop Benny Catchings led Auburn's six-hit offense with a double and single. Tiger leftfielder Alan Koch slammed a two-run home run in the eighth.
