The Seminoles took a quick
1-0 lead yesterday, when two
errors and second baseman Jack
Dull's single produced a first-
inning run. Florida went ahead,
2-1, in the third when McGriff's
bouncer leaped over Ernie Lan-
ford's head at short.

For all purposes, it was over
when FSU batted around for
four runs in the fifth inning.
Ray Buzzell's double, rightfield-
er Jimmy White's bunt single,
two walks, and singles by Dull
and Lanford sent Florida start-
er Ray Oestricher to the show-
ers.

The Gators got one run back
in the fifth on an error and
McGriff's single. Two more FSU
runs crossed the plate in the
seventh on an error, and singles
by Dull, John King and Davis.
The final Seminole run came
in the eighth on a walk and cen-
terfielder Bob Clem's solid blast
to the rightfield fence that went
for three bases.

FSU outlit the Gators, 12-7
with Dull collecting three hits
and Lanford two. Nine of 10
Seminoles who saw action hit
safely.

Yesterday's triumph snapped a
three-game FSU losing streak,
all by one run. FSU is 10-9 for
the season. Florida has a 15-10
season record.
