Florida State and Auburn baseball teams brought out the heavy artillery in a doubleheader here yesterday and after scoring a total of 39 runs on 52 hits the clubs were all even.

Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles won the first game, 10-9, on a ninth-inning rally, but Auburn bounced back to take the second game, 15-5.

FOUR GAMES

The first-game decision pushed FSU's winning streak to four games before the visiting Tigers handed the Tribe its first 1961 setback. Auburn snapped a three-game drouth with its victory. FSU had won the opener of a three-game series Monday by a 10-1 score.

The bats of Auburn outfielders Larry Nichols and Jack Bludworth and of FSU second baseman Jack Dull made the most noise.

Nichols had a tremendous day. In the two games, the Birmingham junior collected nine hits—including four doubles and a pair of booming home runs—and batted in 12 runs. He hit a grand slam homer and drove in five runs in the first game and chased in seven runs with a three-run home run, two doubles and a pair of singles in the second game.

Bludworth smacked a home run in each game and had five hits for the day. Dull finished the twin bill with six hits that included a first-game double and two home runs in the second game.

As they have done in three of their four triumphs this season, the Seminoles came from behind to win the opener. Nichols' grand slam and *Bludworth's round-tripper wiped out a five-run FSU lead and Auburn had a 9-8 edge

entering the last of the ninth.

Bob Madison opened FSU's half with a single to right and moved to second on Dull's single. Madison scored the tying run and Dull moved to third on first baseman Doug Walker's single to right. Dull tagged up and scored the winning run on shortstop Kyle Spitzer's sacrifice fly to right.

Tallahassee sophomore Frank Echols was the winning pitcher after getting Auburn out in the top of the ninth. With the score tied, 3-3, in the second game, Nichols sent the Tigers ahead to stay with a runscoring double to the base of the center-field fence. Four more Tiger runs crossed that inning and Auburn added three more in the seventh and four in the eighth.

Mack Whitaker went all the way for Auburn in the second game, holding the Seminoles to a season-low eight hits. Five FSU pitchers worked, with starter Ray McShane the loser.

FSU has averaged nine runs for its first five games. The Semnoiles meet Navy in single games in Jacksonville Friday and Saturday.
