

The Tigers clubbed Florida State, 12-7, yesterday, largely through the batting of junior third baseman Wayne Fowler, who hit three home runs and batted in seven runs.

Fowler's teammate, Bill Breakfield, got one home run. And Florida State's sophomore shortstop, Woody Woodward, hit two homers.

Auburn took an early lead and held it until the fourth inning, when FSU pulled even. In the fifth inning, Woodward rapped a home run which gave the Seminoles a 6-5 lead.

But Auburn sewed up the game in the sixth with four runs. Fowler hit a homer with two on and Breakfield, following Fowler to the plate, got his homer.

Woodward rapped out four of FSU's 11 hits. He batted in three runs. No other Seminole had more than one hit.

Auburn yoked on five FSU pitchers for 16 hits. Soph Martin Howell was the loser in relief.
