

AUBURN — Jumping to a 3-0 lead in the first inning, Auburn's baseball team won its fourth straight victory over Florida State, 5-3, here yesterday.

FSU now owns an 8-5 record.

Auburn's early scores came when Larry Nichols was hit by a pitch, Wayne Fowler walked and Bill Breakfield slammed a 365-foot home run over the right-center field fence.

Auburn got another run in the fourth on an error, single, wild pitch and sacrifice fly.

The Tigers scored again in the fifth on two walks, single, and a fly to right field.

FSU scored in the fifth on a single by Gary Elliot. Larry Hawkins hit a grounder to Otis Bibb who bobbled it. A walk to Doug French loaded the bases and Ellis came home on Spitzer's fielder's choice.

Woody Woodward led off the eighth with a single. Billy Williamson reached first on Bibb's error. Hal Mangin singled in Woodward and Elliot's sacrifice fly scored Williamson.

FSU out hit the Tigers, 12-5. Elliot was 3-for-3 for the Seminoles. Woodward and Williamson collected two hits apiece.

Woodward has hit safely in all 13 FSU games.
