It was the fifth victory in a row for the Seminoles now 15-9 for the season, They whipped Southern yesterday. The Lakeland school finished with a 13-12 mark.

Florida State had to hustle back with three runs in the final. two innings after blowing a 9-0 lead. The Moccasins picked up two runs in the fourth, five in the sixth and three in the top of the eighth to lead 10-9.

The Tribe's two runs in its half of the eighth provided a momentary lead, but Southern tied it at 11-all in the ninth.
