

With the bases loaded and one away in the last of the ninth, Florida State's Hal Mangin smashed a sacrifice fly that brought in Al Beccaccio with the winning run in a 12-11 baseball victory over Florida Southern here yesterday.

Mangin also banged a double and single in three official trips to the plate.

FIFTH STRAIGHT

It was the fifth victory in a row for the Seminoles now 15-9 for the season. They whipped Southern yesterday. The Lakeland school finished with a 13-12 mark.

Florida State had to hustle back with three runs in the final two innings after blowing a 9-0 lead. The Moccasins picked up two runs in the fourth, five in the sixth and three in the top of the eighth to lead 10-9.

The Tribe's two runs in its half of the eighth provided a momentary lead, but Southern tied it at 11-all in the ninth.

Florida State blasted 17 hits in one of its biggest days at the plate. Beccaccio stroked a triple and three singles in six trips to lead the assault. He scored three runs, drove in another, stole three bases.

Bill Williamson went 3-for-5. Bob Wilcox was 2-for-6. The Seminoles' Bob Madison clouted a 1-run homer in the first inning. It was his sixth of the year and ties him with Williamson for the season leadership.

FERRAR WINNER

Reliever Robert Ferrar (1-0) got credit for the victory. He pitched only one ball, that pinch-hitter Steve Finn popped out to left to retire the side in the ninth.

Starter Jack Ross went 5 2-3 innings. Tommy Davis and Allen Thomas both saw relief duty before Ferrar came on.

For Southern, Rick Duncan went 2-for-4 and John Pavlus had a double and single in five trips.

FSU closes out its home season against Georgia Southern tomorrow and Tuesday. Sophomore Davis is the likely starter in tomorrow's 3:30 p.m. tilt.

The Seminoles end their season against new Southeastern Conference champion Florida in Gainesville Friday and Saturday.
