

Using a pair of homers to score three early runs, Georgia Southern's baseball team went on to bounce Florida State, 4-2, here yesterday.

It broke a five - game win streak of the Seminoles and put their record at 15-10. Southern, 13-6 for the year, was scheduled to go with E. G. Meybohm (0-1) in today's 3:30 p. m. game. FSU was responsible for Meybohm's loss three weeks ago.

Righthander Allen Thomas of Cairo (3-1) was the likely starter for FSU. It is the final home game for the Tribe.

The Georgians' Charles Tarpley led off the second inning with a home run over the rightfield fence. In the third inning with two away, Tommy Jones walked and Mickey Allen bashed his fourth homer of the year for two more runs.

Georgia Southern picked up another run in the eighth when Tarpley singled, moved to third on two straight walks, came home on Buzzy McMillan's single to right.

FSU's Bill Williamson led off the bottom of the second with his seventh homer of the year. That broke a school record held by Fred Twomey in 1955 and Jack Dull in 1959.

FSU's other run came in the third when Al Beccaccio singled to center and moved to third when Southern's Bill Griffin and Jones

collided going after Woody Woodward's pop fly single. Beccaccio scored on a wild pitch.

Woodward collected half of FSU's four hits in three trips. Starter Tommy Davis, now 0-1, and reliever Larry Hawkins who went six innings, yielded just seven safeties to the Georgians. Allen and Tarpley each went 2-for-5 for the winners.
