

MIAMI—Allen Thomas boosted his record to 4-0 as he pitched Florida State's baseball team to a 2-1, come-from-behind victory over the University of Miami Monday.

Both Thomas and losing pitcher Wayne Hines pitched the full nine innings. Thomas threw 87 pitches. Hines 96.

Miami drew first blood when outfielder Sam Yaroshuck picked up a single in the fourth inning, was then knocked in by Dick Panther's double.

FSU retaliated in the fifth when second baseman Jim Reed made first on a grounder, stole second, walked to third and was

brought home by Mike Augustine's single.

The winning run came in the eighth as outfielder Gary Nichols wrapped a double, was sent in for the point by catcher Buddy Teagle's single to right field.

The win boosted Coach Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles to an 8-2 record. The team was scheduled to play again here this afternoon.

Making the trip with the varsity were the freshmen Seminoles, who fell to Dade County Junior College 12-1 yesterday.
