

Old Ranew limited Auburn to six hits, struck out 11 batters and drove in two runs as the Seminoles defeated the Tigers 4-1 here yesterday.

It was the fourth win of the season for the lanky senior from Albany, Ga. and brings the FSU record to 11-3 overall. Another game against Auburn was scheduled here this afternoon.

Pinch hitter Dean Duchak provided some late FSU excitement with a two-run homer to right center.

Auburn put the first run on the board in the third when shortstop Scott Long led off with a long triple to centerfield, then scored on pitcher Jimmy Crysel's sacrifice fly in center.

Florida State came back in the home half as Pete Sarron led with a walk and scored from first on Ranew's hard-hit double to right center.

Dick Fernandez went out on a fly to right and Maury Hopkins struck out but Mike Martin lined a single to left to score Ranew. Martin had tripled with two out in the first inning, giving him two hits for the afternoon.

An Auburn double play left the sacks bare for Gary Lawrence's single in the fourth, and the Seminoles could muster no action in the fifth, but two unearned runs in the sixth gave Ranew all the cushion he needed.

Randy Brown drew a base on balls, and was sacrificed to second by Tom Thomas. Then things got rough for Auburn first baseman Rennie Baynes.

He erred on Lawrence's grounder, moving Brown to third. Gerry Chmielewski came in to run for Lawrence.

Sarron dribbled one to the right side of the pitcher's mound and again Baynes lost the handle. Brown scored and Chmielewski went to second.

Auburn Coach Paul Nix then called in Jerry Lawter from the bullpen to face Ranew. The Seminole pitcher lashed a single, scoring Chmielewski.

Two were out in the eighth when Duchak came on to pinch-hit for Bob Wilcox. The stocky sophomore from Midland Park, N. J., who has been utilized almost exclusively as a pinch-hitter so far this season, hit one into the pines in right center scoring Fernandez ahead of him.
