

CLEMSON, S.C.—Clemson pecked away at Florida State for five innings and finally pulled out a 9-8 baseball victory here yesterday.

It was the Seminoles' third loss in a row to an Atlantic Coast Conference team and brings the FSU record to 15-6. The two teams were scheduled to play a doubleheader today.

Clemson catcher Eddie Barbary lined a bases-loaded single in the ninth inning to drive in the winning run.

It was a day of frustration for Florida State and pitcher Cliff Ranew, who lost his second game of the year against six victories.

The Seminoles led by seven runs when Clemson started a surge in the bottom of the fourth. Ranew had not given up a hit when Tiger first baseman Ellis Dantzler led off inning with a home run. Rusty Adkins also homered for Clemson, and Jackie McCall added a three-run blow in the eighth.

Florida State got seven of its eight runs in the fourth. All were unearned.

Pete Sarren led off with a single, and Mike Martin was on by an error on the second baseman. Tom Thomas's grounder forced Sarren at third, but Randy Brown's single drove in Martin from second.

Gerry Chmielewski singled to lead the bases, and Thomas came home on Gary Lawrence's grounder.

Ranew singled in another run and Dick Fernandez hit an inside the park home run to score four more.

The Seminoles added another run in the seventh when Bob

Wilcox walked, Martin doubled, and Wilcox came home on Brown's sacrifice fly.

McCall's homer in the eighth tied the score, and the Tigers pushed across their run in the ninth. The winning hit came off reliefer Bob Kull, and was Barbary's third of the day.
