

Sophomore Wayne Vincent got his varsity baseball career off to an auspicious start Wednesday afternoon, pitching a two-hitter and hitting a grand-slam home run as Florida State ripped Kentucky 7-0 for its third straight victory.

Vincent was in control all the way.

He gave up a single through the box to Hank Degener in the second, and a single to left by Rick Anderson in the fourth. Not one Kentucky baserunner reached second base against the lefthander. He walked one and struck out 10.

Vincent had two singles plus his home run. His first single hit the 321-foot sign in right field.

Second basemen Chico Fernandez rapped a double and triple in three trips. Shortstop Maury Hopkins and right fielder Jim Lyttle each had a pair of singles, while Tommy Thomas cracked a sixth-inning home run.

~~Starter Randy Cox took the~~ loss for Kentucky. He pitched scoreless ball for four innings before tiring, gave up nine hits and three of the runs.

The Seminoles left runners on three of the first four frames, but finally in the fifth took a 1-0 lead.

Fernandez led off with a double to left. Vincent singled him to third. A wild pitch allowed Fernandez to score after two outs.

The Seminoles picked up two more off Cox in the sixth. Thomas led with a home run to right center. Mike Martin got the other, scoring on Fernandez's triple to left center.

The Seminoles got their final four runs off relief pitcher Eddie Stanko.

Hopkins ripped a single to right with one out in the eighth. Stanko walked Martin and Fernandez was hit by a pitch.

On a 3-1 count Vincent poked a Stanko fast ball over the right center field fence for a grand slam.

It was the fourth Seminole home run in two days.

The Seminoles will wrap up the series with Kentucky this afternoon with righthander Jim Ward on the mound.

Florida State will play Tennessee tomorrow at 3 p.m. Tennessee and Kentucky will play at 11 a.m. The Seminoles will meet Tennessee in a 1:30 p.m. game Saturday.

Auburn and Mississippi State

will be here Monday and Tuesday. The Seminoles will play each team once.
