

With Lin Garrett pitching—a 5-hitter, Florida State lifted its baseball record to 5-2 with a 1-0 triumph over Auburn last night.

Earlier in the day the Seminoles had knocked off Springfield 3-1. A morning game between Georgia and Auburn was rained out.

The Seminoles' invitational tournament continues today with FSU playing Virginia Tech at 7:30 tonight following a 3 p.m. game between the Seminoles and Springfield. Auburn was to meet Springfield in a morning game.

Lone run in last night's tense game came in the sec-

ond-inning after Marv Stringfellow gained second on a 2-base error by Scotty Long, the shortstop. Dick Gold's long double to right-center scored Stringfellow.

Garrett struck out 11 Auburn players, walked just four.

He pitched himself out of a jam in the fourth. With runners on third and second—after a single, error and wild pitch—and no one out, Garrett fanned the next two batters. He walked a Tiger to load the bases before sitting down pinch-hitter Ty Copinger on strikes.

In yesterday's afternoon

contest LaDon Boyd threw a four-hitter at Springfield for the triumph.

The Tribe managed only five hits off a pair of Maroon hurlers, but made them stand up for three runs.

The first tally came in the fourth on the first of three singles by Lance Hitchcock, the Seminoles big leftfielder.

He went to second on a passed ball, to third on a ground out. Springfield starter Bill Barry was called for a balk, and Hitchcock walked home with the run.

The Maroons evened the count quickly, however, when Chuck Lelas unloaded his second homer in as many days. The first baseman's big blow came after Boyd had put down the first twelve men he faced in order.

The Tribe utilized a walk to Harry Greene, a stolen base and Hitchcock's second single for the go-ahead run in the sixth.

Boyd went the distance for the Seminoles, striking out eight while not allowing a walk.

Tomorrow's tourney schedule sends Alabama against Virginia Tech at 11 a.m., Alabama against Penn State at 3 p.m., and FSU against Penn State at 7:30 p.m.
