LAKELAND — Playing in wind-driven rain, Florida State and Florida Southern baseball teams ended in a 5-5 tie Thursday when the game was called after seven innings because of the weather.

Today Florida State takes on the University of Miami at the Hurricanes field.

After two scoreless innings, the Seminoles jumped ahead by one when Dave Moates singled, stole second and was driven home on a single by Dick Gold.

Florida Southern pitcher Mike Dwyer led off the bottom of the third with a single. A hit by Terry Snell sent Dwyer to second, and he took third on an error by FSU's Walt Sumner.

With two runners on, Gary Morgan tapped an infield hit, scoring Dwyer. Snell tallied when a pickoff attempt from Gold to Mike Easom was overthrown.

Southern got two more runs in the fourth after putting two men on via errors. Mike Bowman scored from second when shortstop Tom Porter ~~overthrew~~ first base. Bob D'Angio took second on the

play, and came home on a double to right by Snell.

In the fifth inning, FSU's Porter led off with a walk and scored on a double by Moates. Moates went to third on an infield hit by Gold, and then scored on a balk by pitcher Dwyer.

~~With one out in the sixth,~~ Doug Kasimier singled. Mike English followed with a hit. Porter rapped a single to ~~center, bringing in Kasimier,~~

and Moates connected for another single, scoring English, to give the Seminoles a 5-4 lead.

Florida Southern got a tying run in the bottom of the seventh, when back-to-back singles by Randy Lewis and Bruce Kinder pushed Page Fullington home.

Righthander Jeff Hill lasted four innings for the Seminoles, giving up four runs on six hits before being relieved by George Lott.

Dwyer went the distance for the Moccassins giving up five runs on 10 hits. He fanned 11 Tribe batters.

Moates, a Manatee JC transfer playing his first game for Florida State, was four-for-four at the plate, drove in two runs and scored twice himself.
