MIAMI — Florida State's Walt Sumner broke open a tight game when he lashed a three-run homer in the top of the eighth to give the Seminoles a 6-2 baseball victory over the University of Miami Friday afternoon.

The Seminoles clash with the Hurricanes again this afternoon here at 1:30.

Florida State shot out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning before Miami came back with two runs in the third to make it close all the way.

The Tribe's Tom Porter got things started right, nailing the first pitch of the afternoon for a single. Dave Moates forced him at second before Dick Gold clobbered a triple sending Moates home.

Still in the first, big Jim Gurzynski connected on a base hit scoring Gold. Greg Schnute followed with another single pushing Gurzynski to second who tallied on an rbi single to left by Sumner.

Miami opened the third inning with a base hit by Joe Green. George Maduro followed with the Hurricanes' only extra base hit, a double into left center.

With two men on, Laddie Jesek rapped a single to right scoring Green. Maduro then came home on an infield hit to third.

The Seminoles managed to hold onto the slim 3-2 lead for four innings before lowering the boom in the eighth.

Miami reliever Dave Patrylo issued walks to Moates and Schnute before Sumner ripped the Seminoles' first home run of the season, a line drive, 385 feet down the left field line.

Tribe righthander Gene Ammann picked up his first win of the season working seven innings. He gave up two runs on five hits. Tom Henson went the final two frames holding Miami hitless.

The Hurricanes' Tom Lehman also went seven. Seminole batters tagged him for three runs on nine hits. Patrylo, who came on for Lehman, gave up three runs on one hit.

After today's game, Florida State travels to Lake Wales to meet St. Leo College on Sunday.
