MIAMI — Walt Summer slammed two home runs as Florida State shut out the University of Miami 5-0 Saturday afternoon and made a clean sweep of the two-game series with the Hurricanes.

It was a three-run homer by Sumner which earned the Seminoles a 6-2 victory over the Hurricanes on Friday.

Florida State began quickly as Tom Porter and Dick Gold drew, walks. First baseman Jim Gurzynski then cracked and rbi single to right sending. Porter homeward.

Gold went to third on an error by Miami rightfielder Larry Pyle and scored on a pass ball by George Maduro.

Sumner's first blast came in the fourth with Greg Schnute on first. He then kayoed a solo

homer in the sixth, both off Hurricane pitcher Tom Borzecki and both, like the one Friday, sailed over the left field fence.

Southpaw Craig Skok went five innings on the mound for Florida State giving up six hits to Miami batters. Twice Skok, a senior transfer from Beoward Junior College? loaded the bases but managed to escape

took over in the sixth and allowed just three hits. For the afternoon, Miami left 43 runners stranded while FSU left on six.

Tribe swatters jumped on loser Borzecki for seven hits and all five runs before he retired in the sixth. Neale Monte relieved in the seventh and was tagged for three more hits before Jim Meulhausen came on in the ninth.

Summer was the big hitter for FSU going two for four, driving in three runs and scoring twice. Second baseman Gold collected three hits in four times at bat.
