Held scoreless for the first time in two years Friday,
Florida State's baseball team took little time in jumping on Auburn Saturday and the Seminoles came away with a 6-1 victory over the Tigers.

In gaining a split of the two game series, the Tribe took full advantage of five Auburn errors while senior lefthander George Lott kept the War Eagle bats quiet most of the afternoon

Lott, going the distance in his first start, gave up just four hits and a walk while striking out eight.

The big lefty had a perfect game going through four and two-thirds innings before the Tigers erupted for their only run in the fifth.

The Seminoles had built up a 3-0 advantage by that time, however, and quickly added another pair in the bottom of the inning to put the game out of reach.

Shortstop Tom Porter started things with a game opening single. Dave Moates followed with a grounder to first, but Auburn first baseman Frank Baldasare threw the ball away at second leaving all hands safe.

Tiger starting pitcher Larry Kain attempted a pickoff at first, but his throw went beyond Baldasare's reach and deep into the rightfield corner. Porter raced home on the error and Moates went to third.

Big Jim Gurzynski followed with a looping single to rightcenter sending Moates home and the Tribe had a quick 2-0 lead.

Second baseman Dick Gold led off the second inning with a solo home run to up the lead to 3-0.

Following Joe Hollis' RBI double in the Auburn fifth, which sent Denny Womack home with the Tigers only run, the Tribe again used a pair of Tiger errors for two tallies.

Moates was safe when Russ Walker bobbled his bouncer to second. After Walt Sumner walked, Gurzynski again came through with an RBI single, sending Moates home.

Mike Easom then sent a grounder to first, but the ball

shot through Baldasare's legs and Sumner scored.

Greg Schnute followed with a sharp grounder to third, Gurzynski was caught in a run down by catcher Hollis, and Easom trying to move to third on the play was doubled up.
