Florida State's suddenlyslumping baseball team came up with another serious rash of errors to give Georgia Tech an 8-5 win and a split of Saturday's doubleheader. The Tribe won the opener, in extra' innings, 2-1.

The Seminoles had six errors in the night cap, three in a seven-run eighth inning that sealed away Tech's win.

The loss was the Tribe's third in five games after winning 21 straight. It dropped the Seminoles' record to 32-8.

George Lott went the distance in the opener to pick up his seventh win of the year for the Tribe. The lefthander

scattered 10 hits, didn't walk a man.

Phil Hudson, meanwhile, held the Tribe bats well in check. A lefty also, he allowed only three hits, but the Seminoles made the most of them.

Lott, who had two of the safeties and scored both runs, opened the third inning with a hit. He moved to second when Walt Sumner was hit by a pitch and then on to third on an infield out. When Hudson uncorked a wild pitch, the Tribe pitcher trotted home.

That run stood up until the fifth when three Tech singles netted a run.

Scheduled as a seven-inning contest, the game went into extra innings and the Seminoles came up with the winning run in the eighth.

Jim Gurzynski walked and Lott followed with a single. Greg Schnute, who was running for Gurzynski went to third. Hudson intentionally walked Sumner to pitch to the left hand swinging Dave Moates who grounded to second, forcing Schnute at home.

Dick Gold then grounded to short, and Brannon Bonifay

fired home wildly and Lott raced across the plate with the winning run.
