With the bases now full and starter Gene Ammann tiring, Coach Jack Stallings called on top reliefer John Ferguson. Ferguson's first pitch was in the dirt and bounded over Keith allowing one run to score.

Bonifay followed with single sending another run home. Hudson, batting for pitcher David Vittur, singled in a run, and when Bobby Gibson doubled home another score Ferguson was sent to the showers

Mike Reibling came on and was greeted by a two-run single from Chip Kays. After the next two batters flew out, Caldwell, batting for the second time in the inning, walked.

Lloyd Harris popped to center, but for the second time in the frame Sumner booted it and Kays scored.

Reibling finally struck out Hargrave to end the inning.

Vittur, who had come on in relief of Tech starter Gary Steele, was the winner, while Ferguson was the loser.

The Seminoles will be trying to put things back in shape before opening a four game road trip to Jacksonville and Georgia Southern Wednesday night.
