GAINESVILLE—Some clutch pitching and fielding enabled Florida State to salvage a split in its doubleheader with the University of Florida at Perry Field Saturday afternoon, both contests won by the same 3-1 count.

The Gators jumped on starter Gene Ammann for six hits in the first game to hand the junior righthander only his second loss in 12 outings this season.

In the third inning, UF starter Mike Jacobs got on with a single. Guy McTheney followed with a base hit sending Jacobs to third where he scored on Leon Bloodworth's single to center.

Dale Turlington continued the attack rifling a single to left, putting McTheney on third. First baseman Skip Lujack then sacrificed bringing McTheney home with the second Gator run of the stanza.

Second baseman Dick Gold started the FSU fourth inning by smacking a shot 400 feet to left-center where McTheney made a saving catch. Jeff Hogan followed with a single before Mike Easom drew a walk. Hogan scored when Dick Nichols tapped a single to left.

Florida sewed up the win in the sixth when Mike Ovca singled, went to second on an infield out and tallied when leftfielder Dave Moates bobbled Will Harmon's deep fly.

The Seminoles had threats going in both the fifth and sixth with two men on each time. But the pitching of Jacobs and ace reliever Glenn Pickren limited the Tribe to five hits and left nine Seminole runners stranded.
