Dowell leads FSU to 9-7 win

ATLANTA - Danny Dowell slammed a two-run double in the seventh inning to give Florida State a 9-7 win over Georgia State Tuesday af-

The win lifted FSU to 46-14-1 for the season. Georgia State, which was seeking a second straight upset, fell

Trailing 7-6, Florida State tied the game in the seventh on Frank Fazzini's leadoff home run - his 13th of the season. Steve Givens and Mike Yastrzemski each singled off Panther starter Herbie Brooks before Dowell greeted relief pitcher Bret McGuire with the game-winning hit.

From that point on, Seminole relief pitcher Doug Treadway took over, retiring 11 of the last 13 batters he faced. Treadway struck out four in the 4% innings he worked to pick up his sixth win of the season against one loss.

Holding on to a 6-3 lead, Florida State ran into trouble in the fifth. FSU starter Jeff Ledbetter gave up a leadoff single before walking the next batter to put two on with no out. Ledbetter struck out McGuire, but a wild pitch and a single by Steve Sparks made it 6-5.

Treadway entered the game and recorded the second out when Joe Carroll's single hit Sparks on the heel as he was advancing to second.

Bill Hulsey drew a walk, and then Allan Warnock singled to tie the game. Georgia State took the lead on

the play when Rick Figueredo overthrew Mark Barineau in an attempt to nail Hulsey at third.

Treadway struck out Tim Os-

bourne to end the inning.
