

Florida State sweeps Southern Mississippi

HATTIESBURG, Miss. — Vince Calandra, Barry Blackwell and Tommy Zoeller each drove in three runs to back the seven-hit pitching of Mike Loynd as the Florida State Seminoles recorded a 17-6 win over Southern Mississippi in the first game of a college-baseball doubleheader Saturday.

Kevin Smith and Ray Revak combined to pitch a one-hitter for a 6-0 FSU win in the second game of the day-night doubleheader.

The first-game victory was Coach Mike Martin's 300th win in his six-year career at Florida State.

The opener was never in doubt

as the Seminoles jumped out to an 11-0 lead after the first five innings of play. Jimmy Jones put the Seminoles on top 1-0 in the first with an RBI single. Blackwell keyed a three run rally in the second inning with a two-run triple off the center field wall.

After adding three more in the third, Florida State made it 8-0 in the fourth as Frank Fazzini ripped his 13th home run of the season to deep right field.

In the second game, Smith pitched the first seven innings and allowed only a fifth-inning sinle to Greg Conner. FSU was led offensively by two-run singles by Luis Alicea and Bien Figueroa.

The Seminoles are 28-10 overall and 5-0 in the Metro Conference. Southern Mississippi is 12-16 and 1-7 in the Metro.
