Florida State 6, Southern Mississippi 4

TALLAHASSEE -- Top-ranked Florida State extended its winning streak to 18 games by completing a three-game Metro Conference sweep of Southern Mississippi, 6-4, in college baseball action Sunday.

The Seminoles, 28-3, 3-0, have not lost since March 1 and have not lost at home in its past 29 contests, dating back to 1990. Southern Miss left Tallahassee with a 13-12, 2-4 record.

Florida State took a 4-0 lead after four innings, then hung on behind the relief pitching of Kenny Robinson. Robinson threw the final 3.1 innings with FSU clinging to a 5-4 lead and gave up only one hit while striking out five. He picked up the save, his fourth, in relief of starter Jimmy Lewis, 7-1.

Lewis retired the first 12 men he faced before surrendering back-to-back doubles by Bill Selby and Chris Robbins in the USM fifth inning. After a strikeout, Chad Hebert singled to score Robbins. Lewis survived the rest of the inning with the help of a failed squeeze attempt by USM, but was replaced in the sixth after leadoff hitter Scott Jurich doubled and Doug Benefiel struck out.

Tim Davis took over for Lewis, but promptly gave up two doubles and a sacrifice fly as the Golden Eagles trimmed FSU's lead to 5-4. Robinson then came on to strike out Larry Wesson to end the inning.

The Seminoles went ahead 1-0 in the first on Eduardo Perez' RBI single which scored Nandy Serrano, who singled, stole second and went to third on an error by catcher Chris Logan. FSU scored twice in the third on a bases-loaded single by Perez. In the fourth, FSU increased its lead to 4-0 on Garrett Blanton's two-out RBI single.

After USM scored two in the fifth off Lewis, the Seminoles added a run in their half of the inning. Allen Bevis doubled, one of three hits on the day for the Seminole second baseman, and stole third. Two outs later, Pedro Grifol singled up the middle to score Bevis.

Florida State added an insurance run in the bottom of the eighth when Ty Mueller doubled off the screen in right field with two outs to score Tony Liebsack.


Bevis led FSU's 14-hit attack while five other Seminoles collected a pair of hits apiece. Perez' two hits drove in three.

Selby had three doubles to tie the USM school record. He was the only Golden Eagle with more than one hit.

Southern Miss returns home to a mid-week series with New Orleans in Hattiesburg while Florida State plays host to Mercer Tuesday and Wednesday in Dick Howser Stadium.
