Florida State 12, Miami 4

TALLAHASSEE -- Nandy Serrano went 3-for-4 with two runs batted in and Tim Davis pitched five-plus innings of two-hit relief to lead second-ranked Florida State to a 12-4 victory over third-ranked Miami Saturday night before a crowd of 6,039 at Dick Howser Stadium.

The win, FSU's 33rd straight at home over the past two seasons, established a new school record for consecutive home wins and improved the Seminoles' 1991 record overall to 36-6. Miami dropped to 34-9 with its second straight loss.

Serrano and Allen Bevis were the offensive stars of the day for Florida State. In addition to Serrano's three hits, Bevis added two hits, reached base four times and scored four runs. Chris Roberts added a run-scoring grounder in the third inning while his two-out, bases loaded single in the fifth scored three runs and gave FSU a 9-4 lead from which they would not look back.

Florida State was helped by Miami, which was charged with six errors on the night, the most the Hurricanes have committed since 1987.

FSU scored a pair of runs in the first and three in the third before exploding for four runs in the fourth to chase UM starter and loser Jeff Alkire, 6-1. Alkire was charged with nine runs, seven earned, in 3.2 innings to take the loss.

Florida State starter Jimmy Lewis did not fare much better, though, as he gave up four runs before being lifted in the fourth after Donald Robinson's two-out, two-run double. Davis came on to retire 15 of the 17 batters he faced, including nine on strikeouts. His record improved to 4-0 on the year.

Miami was led by Robinson and Mike Tosar, who each collected a pair of hits on the night. Lewis and Davis combined to strike out 15 Hurricanes.

Florida State has taken the first two games of this intra-state series which concludes Sunday at 1 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
