TALLAHASSEE -- In a pitching shootout at Dick Howser Stadium, Florida State righthander Paul Wilson out-dueled Florida's Rob Bonanno to give the Seminoles a 2-0 victory over the Gators in college baseball Thursday night before a crowd of 2,913.

Wilson, a sophomore from Orlando, laid claim to the No. 1 spot in FSU's pitching rotation with a four-hitter over 13th-ranked Florida. Wilson, 4-0, struck out a career high 10 and walked two en route to the first complete game of his career. He did not allow a hit after the fourth inning and retired the last 14 UF batters he faced.

Bonanno was equally as impressive, almost. He gave up only three hits and struck out a career high 10 in the game, but saw his record drop to 3-1 on the year.

Florida State took a 1-0 lead in the first. Randy Hodges walked and stole second. He came around to score on an error by UF first baseman Chris Kokinda.

In the fifth, FSU doubled its lead thanks to a leadoff triple by Grady Jordan. Jordan scored on a sacrifice fly by Hodges.

Florida threatened in two innings. In the second, UF loaded the bases with two out on a pair of hit batsmen and a single, but Wilson struck out Brian Duva to end the threat. The Gators got back-to-back two-out singles in the fourth before James Ramos grounded out on an excellent defensive play by FSU second baseman Chad Sheffer.

Tenth-ranked Florida State improved to 9-2 with the victory while Florida's record fell to 9-5. The four-game series continues Friday night at 7 p.m. in Tallahassee before shifting to Gainesville this weekend for the final two games.
