Florida State 4, North Carolina 3 (10 innings)

TALLAHASSEE -- A bases loaded walk to Jack Niles in the bottom of the 10th inning scored Mickey Lopez with the winning run to give Florida State a 4-3 victory over North Carolina in Atlantic Coast Conference baseball action Sunday. The win gave FSU a two-game sweep of the weather-shortened series and improved the Seminoles' record to 15-3 on the year, 2-0 in the ACC. North Carolina stands 9-5, 0-2.

Carolina pitcher Tom Hawkins, the sixth UNC pitcher of the day and third used in the 10th inning, walked Niles on a 3-1 pitch to score Lopez. The previous two FSU batters had also walked. Lopez led off the 10th with an infield single off UNC pitcher Brian Willman, who took the loss to fall to 0-1 on the year.

Tar Heel pitchers walked 14 Seminole batters but allowed only five hits on the day. Three Florida State pitchers struck out 14 but walked only two. FSU's Phil Olson, who retired UNC in order in the 10th, got the win to improve his record to 2-1.

UNC took a 2-0 lead after six innings on a solo home run by Chris Cox in the fifth and Mitch Jones' RBI single in the sixth. Florida State tied the score in its half of the seventh. Grady Jordan and Kevin McCray walked to start the inning. After a sacrifice bunt advanced the runners, Niles drove in Jordan with a sacrifice fly. Randy Hodges then singled to scored McCray.

The Seminoles fell behind 3-2 when UNC's Chris Madonna doubled to drive in Chad Holbrook in the Tar Heel ninth. A second runner trying to score on the double was cut down at the plate. Florida State came back in its half of the ninth to send the game to extra frames. With the bases loaded and two out, Mike Martin hit a bloop single over third base to score Hodges, who had singled.

Hodges and Martin each collected two hits for Florida State. David Boone went 3-for-5 to lead UNC, while Madonna and Keith Grunewald had two hits apiece.

Florida State takes on Virginia in a three-game series starting Tuesday at 5 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
