Florida State 5, Northern Iowa 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Sixth-ranked Florida State (21-3) got another fine pitching peformance, and Randy Hodges hit a two-run home run as the Seminoles completed a three-game sweep of Northern Iowa with a 5-2 win Sunday before 1,612 at Dick Howser Stadium.

Lefthander Bryan Harris (3-1) worked eight innings without walking a batter, scattering seven hits and striking out seven to win his third consecutive start. Charlie Cruz pitched a perfect ninth to earn his first save.

Florida State has won eight straight and 13 of its last 14, getting outstanding pitching. Seminole hurlers have allowed just nine walks and fanned 84 hitters over the last eight games.

The Panthers (4-10) took a 1-0 lead in the second inning when Tom Owen laid down a squeeze bunt to score Monty Muller.

Tied at 1-1 in the fourth, Hodges duplicated Owen's bunt to put FSU on top, scoring Mike Martin who had singled to extend his current hitting streak to 12 games.

Hodges hit a two-run homer over the screen in right in the sixth to give FSU a 4-1 lead.

Rob McCormick led off the top of the eighth with a solo homer for UNI.

Florida State will spend its spring break in North Carolina. The Seminoles will play three-game Atlantic Coast Conference sets at Duke and N.C. State during the week, opening with Duke Monday at 3 p.m. Paul Wilson (6-0, 1.19) will start on the hill for Florida State.
