Florida State 6, Miami 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Fourth-ranked Florida State completed a three-game sweep of Miami with a 6-2 victory before an Easter Sunday crowd of 3,713 at Dick Howser Stadium. Led by the pitching of John Wasdin and the hitting of catcher Mike Martin, the Seminoles won their sixth straight game to up their record to 31-7 on the year. Miami dropped to 22-14 with the loss.

Wasdin, 7-1, turned in the third straight strong outing by an FSU starter with seven and two-thirds innings of work. The junior struck out nine and did not walk a batter while holding the Hurricanes scoreless through seven.

Wasdin allowed only two singles, and three total baserunners, until UM's Chad Rupp led off the eighth with a home run. After giving up a single to Chris Stafford and an RBI double to Bruce Thompson, Wasdin was lifted for reliever John Nedeau, who recorded his third save of the year.

FSU pitchers gave up only 14 hits and three runs in the three-game series.

The Seminoles took a 1-0 lead off UM starter Fadul Arrieta (4-3) in the second. Martin singled for the first of his two hits on the day, went to second on a fielder's choice and scored on Scott Schroeffel's RBI single.

A four-run FSU uprising in the fourth proved Arrieta's downfall. Mike Schmitz and Mickey Lopez each collected RBI hits in the inning. Schmitz doubled to drive in Doug Mientkiewicz while Lopez' single to left scored two. Chad Sheffer also drove in a run with a hit in the inning.

In addition to his two singles, Martin scored three runs. Sheffer was the only other Seminole with more than one hit. Miami's five hits were scattered among five different players.

Sunday's victory gives Florida State a perfect 7-0 record against intra-state rivals Miami and Florida in 1993. The Seminoles return to action next Friday for the opener of a three-game series with ACC foe Wake Forest.
