FLORIDA STATE FIGHTS OFF N.C. STATE, 5-4, IN ACC BASEBALL

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- No. 4 Florida State (26-4, 10-0 ACC) fought off No. 12 N.C. State's bid for a comeback as the Seminoles won their 18th consecutive game, a 5-4 victory over the Wolfpack.

"This was a good test for the team in the ninth inning against one of the top teams in the ACC," commented Coach Mike Martin.

FSU first baseman Matt Woodward turned in a career-high three hits, beginning with a two-run basehit in the second inning to give the Seminoles a 2-0 lead.

Rightfielder Steve Nedeau drove in J.D. Drew for FSU's third run in the third inning. Nedeau finished with a 3-for-4 outing. Second baseman Scott Zech extended his hitting streak to 12 games with a RBI-double in the fifth inning, driving in J.D. Drew who led off the inning with a walk.

Designated-hitter Billy Brown led off the sixth with double and scored on Brooks Badeaux' single to centerfield giving FSU a 5-0 advantage. Brown had two doubles on the night.

Sophomore left-hander Randy Choate (9-1) struck out 10 batters enroute to his seventh consecutive victory. Choate pitched shutout ball for six innings, but N.C. State (25-5, 5-2 ACC) would not give up as the team rallied in the seventh with three consecutive hits. N.C. State first baseman Scott Lawler contributed a RBI-double and catcher Robby Lasater drove in a run on a ground out to third base.

Lawler led off the ninth inning with a double, and Lasater then hit a two-run homer off reliever Randy Niles to make it a one-run ball game. Freshman left-hander Zach Diaz earned his first save of the season as Michael Terhune flew out to centerfield for the last out of the game.

N.C. State starter Corey Lee (6-1) suffered his first loss of the season as he gave up five runs on nine hits and four walks.
