NO. 10 FSU DROPS MAGIC NUMBER TO TWO WITH 8-1 WIN OVER MARYLAND Scott Toole records a career-high four hits & Blair Varnes earns win number seven

College Park, Md. – The No. 10 Florida State Seminoles (36-14, 16-3 ACC) defeated Maryland (15-32, 4-17 ACC) by a score of 8-1 at Shipley Field. FSU is now two games away from clinching the ACC regular season title. A win on Saturday over the Terps coupled with a Clemson loss would clinch the championship for the Tribe. Junior Scott Toole, starting tonight at shortstop, led the Seminoles at the plate as he had a career-high four hits in the leadoff spot. Nick Rogers added three hits of his own while starting pitcher Blair Varnes earned the victory to move to 7-1 on the season.

FSU jumped out to a 2-0 lead with a pair of runs in the top of the first inning. Toole led off with a base hit bunt and John-Ford Griffin followed with a double off the screen in right center to put runners on second and third. Ryan Barthelemy knocked in Toole with a sacrifice fly to left and Mike Futrell followed with an RBI-single to score Griffin.

UM's Kevin McDonald cut the lead in half with a home run to lead off the top of the second.

The Seminoles got the run back in the top of the fifth when Futrell tripled home Barthelemy with two outs. Barthelemy had singled and stole second prior to Futrell's second RBI of the game.

In the top of the eighth, FSU added three insurance runs to push the lead to 6-1. Rogers reached on a bunt single and advanced to third on a throwing error. Karl Jernigan then doubled off the wall in center for the RBI. After Jeff Probst was intentionally walked, he and Jernigan moved up to second and third on a failed pick-off attempt at second. The Terps loaded the bases with one out with another intentional walk, this one to Bryan Zech. Jernigan and Probst scored the next two runs on back-to-back wild pitches by starter Todd Ainsworth.

Jeff Probst and Bryan Zech had run-scoring base hits in the ninth to make it 8-1.

Varnes worked six innings and allowed one earned run on four hits. The junior, who entered the week as the ACC's strikeout leader, picked up three K's and walked two.

Daniel Hodges earned his third save of the season as he held the Terps scoreless over the final three innings.

Ainsworth took the loss after giving up six earned runs on 10 hits in 7.1 innings of work. Ainsworth walked five and struck out four.

The series continues Saturday at 7:00 with FSU LHP Matt Lynch (6-2) on the hill against UM RHP Steve Schmoll (2-6).
