

TONIGHT'S GAME

Tonight's opponent, Memphis State, shifted its ground game into high gear earlier in the season and since then has romped over five straight opponents.

Headlining that rushing attack is a 5-7 tailback who weighs only 172 pounds but still manages to bowl over tacklers. Paul (Skeeter) Gowen was the spark Memphis State needed to ignite the fire.

The Memphis sophomore had his biggest night against Cincinnati when he rushed for an amazing 260 yards in 17 carries, good for two touchdowns. Understandably, this was a school record.

For the season, Gowen has 594 yards and five touchdowns for an impressive 6.3 average.

Like Florida State, Memphis State went into the season with an inexperienced offensive line. However, the Tiger forwards matured against Cincinnati and things have looked up since.

Gowen isn't the only dangerous Tiger in the backfield. Seminole fans remember quarterback Rick Thurrow from 1967 when the speedster broke a long touchdown run on the option play.

Memphis State has gone to the "triple option" this fall and this presents Florida State with a definite defensive problem. Starting quarterback Danny Pierce, a 216 pounder, has the option of running himself or slipping the ball to Gowen or fullback Jay McCoy, a Miami junior.

If Florida State plans to throw against the Tigers, it would seem the Seminoles should be particularly careful when the pass is directed in the neighborhood of secondary men David Berrong and Steve Jaggard. They have intercepted seven apiece.

The Seminoles' ground game has also improved lately. For the third straight game Florida State has had a runner to rush for over 100 yards. Against Virginia Tech, Paul Magalski picked up 113 yards, giving him his second straight 100-plus game.

Florida State's defense has been tougher as the season progresses and now is among the country's top 20 in defense against scoring. The Seminoles have given up an average of 13 points per contest.

Memphis State and Florida State have faced two mutual opponents. The Tigers downed Miami 26-13 and Tulsa 42-24 while the Seminoles edged Miami 16-14 and beat Tulsa 38-20.

Florida State leads the series, 2-1.
