VINCE GIBSON QUOTES:

"It was miserable. This was by far the worst we played all year. I really don't know what happened. Florida State played inspired football and we didn't. That last game at Nebraska really took it out of us.

"We just played bad in every way and Florida State played very well. This Warren is a fine quarterback. We weren't aggressive, we didn't do a good job of rushing the passer or covering the corners. Florida State has fine receivers, good personnel, but we just didn't do a good job ~~at~~ ~~at~~ anything.

"This ~~was~~ was our worst defensive play of the season. Before, we had a pretty good pass rush. Today ~~we~~ didn't do anything.

"Yes, we finished with ~~a~~ a winning season(6-5 record) but it was a shame to end up like this. I thought we would play with a little more inspiration than we did. It's hard to point your finger at the reason.

"I'll say this for Florida State, they're well coached and have come a long ways since the start of the season. They're a lot better now than earlier. No, I can't compare them to Nebraska. Nebraska is possibly the No. 1 team in the nation. Nebraska has more people than Florida State. It's unfair to compare the two teams.

"Two weeks ago~~and~~ we were a pretty good football team. But the last two weeks we have looked horrible. It gets late in the year and I ~~guess~~ we didn't have anything to play for.

COACH BILL PETERSON

"Our kids were ready to play. I ~~had~~ told them Friday night that they had a big thing to overcome but that is what MEN do.

"We gave the game ball to ~~defen~~ defensive coach Bob Harbison. He is an assistant ^{who} ~~so~~ didn't come to Florida State just for a cup of coffee.

"Never in my 11 years here have I seen a defensive team play better. As a matter of fact, it might have been the best effort for the whole team.

"That was the finest hitting we've had in 3 or 4 years. This has to be one of my sweetest victories.

"Warren has never been better. Actually, we were down in there two or three times when we might have scored more.

"I think we're a good football team. We're exciting because we do so many things. We'd play anybody in a bowl--Notre Dame, Nebraska, anyone.

"We tried to give Dickey a lot of different looks. We thought confusion might force him into mistakes.

"Beryl Rice came up with two straight big plays. He's done a tremendous job replacing Wallace.

"It was a great victory."
