COACH PAT DYE QUOTES

"It was just a long night. It was long from the very first play. We gave them the turnover and they scored. Then we turned it over again and they got another score. That was the way it went all day.

"Florida State had 360 yards of total offense and they've gotten more than that against us in previous years. We never did anything offensively to create some momentum and give us hope. They basically dominated in all aspects of the game.

"The one positive thing was that we didn't give up a big play on the kicking game. They didn't block a punt.

"This is very disappointing to say the least. It is a monumental task to put this one behind us and get ready for a very good Georgia team. It will take total concentration throughout the week.

"We had a lot of momentum coming into the game. I was afraid after the emotional win that we may not be able to get back to that peak for the second straight week. Florida and Georgia are always very emotional games for us and this season we had Florida State sandwiched in between them.

"I don't know how good we are. I think we have a chance to be a good team. Florida State took advantage of every opportunity tonight. It was obvious that the level they were playing on and the level we were playing on were entirely different levels.

"We couldn't establish any consistency on offense. And we didn't score touchdowns when we got down close. Then we got so far behind that their defense could play pass on every down.

"I would like to congratulate Coach Bowden and his staff. I thought coming in that Florida State had a very, very good football team. Now I know they do. I have never seen a team that has as much talent and quickness at the skilled positions. They are two and three deep in most of the skilled positions.

"We have displayed class all year long when we were winning. I hope the players, coaches and fans can continue to display that class even though we lost."
