"I've got to hand it to Memphis State, they fought awfully hard. I felt like the outplayed us in the second half and they just never quit. And I have to hand it to our players for doing what we had to. We didn't execute very well. We beat them with pure skill. I was disappointed in some of the shenanigans on the sideline, but I thought we played pretty well in th-e first half.

"I would like to have been able to leave Peter Tom in the second half. He could've gotten the record easily. He did a great job and our receivers did a great job. I don't think we can beat Florida if we play like we did today. It was tough to come -out in the second half and play real well. I'm just glad Memph-is State played so hard. I think that's a good sign for Coach- Stobart. A sign they're going in the right direction.

"We didn't really plan to throw that much, but our first couple of running plays didn't gain much and the passing game was eatin' it up in big chunks.

"They're a good team. They have speed and they showed what you can do with speed. I thought our guys hung in there in a tough situation and kept trying. Tim Jones in particular was one of those guys. Even toward the end of the game when we had a bunch of walk-ons in there, they were trying hard.

"We couldn't handle their passing game in the first half. One of the big keys though were our fumbles. It's still a close game and we fumble on a first down play and then on the following kickoff and that decided the game.

"I was surprised that they passed as much as they did. I was surprised when they came out throwing in the second half. They were trying to get something and I guess they got what they were looking for because they eventually stopped.

"We definitely have to have some speed. We must recruit speed to compete with these guys."

## Florida State Notes & Quotes

Peter Tom Willis threw for a career high 482 yards, the second-highest total in Florida State history. His 452 yards in total offense was also the second-best single game performance.

His six touchdown passes today is a new FSU single game record. The previous record of five was held by Gary Huff (10/23/71 vs. South Carolina) and Bill Cappleman (10/23/68 vs. Wake Forest).

It was the fifth time this season (in 10 games) Peter Tom has thrown for 300 or more yards in a game, adding to his record established last game against South Carolina.

Willis' totals rank second on the single season passing yard list, trailing Gary Huff by 88 yards. He threw for 2,893 yards in 1972. His 189 completions also rank second on the single season list, 17 behind Huff's 206 in 1972. He has 2,711 yards in total offense this season and needs 60 yards to break the FSU single season total offense record, held by Huff who had 2,770 in 1972. With six touchdown passes today, he moves into fourth place on the FSU single season list with 17 on the year. See page 124 of the FSU media guide for more.

On the career charts, Willis now has 3,814 yards to rank third behind only Huff and Cappleman. His 3,972 career passing yards ranks fifth as he passed Chip Ferguson. He has 30 career touchdown- passes, fifth on the career list. His 284 career completions is fourth on the FSU all-time list.

Willis also broke the FSU single game record for most yards per attempt with 15.5 (482 yards on 31 attempts).

Florida State's crowd of 57,511 today gives the Seminoles a total this season of 368,159 for a home average of 61,360 -- a new season high. The previous high was 57,305 average in 1986.
