FSU vs. Clemson -- Post-Game Notes & Quotes

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"After today, I think I'm going to quit coaching the entire team and just take over Brooks and Ward. I can't look bad coaching those two. Brooks might be the best defensive player in the country and Charlie was just outstanding. I never thought we would have a shutout today. I also never thought we would score that many points. We had a little cold spell in the second quarter. We had some fumbles, but other than that I was very pleased.

"Clemson played a lot of young guys. A lot of the game was that we wore them down. We just had more people than they did. It was hot and they wore down. I think they really got tired chasing a guy like Charlie. That really took it out of them. I can't tell you how pleased I am with the defense. They played four great quarters today. If they keep playing like that, we've got a chance every time we play. I still can't tell a great deal about us because we don't know the strength of our opponents. I do know one thing, when we execute like we did today, and we play that kind of defense, we will be hard to beat."

Clemson Head Coach Ken Hatfield:

"Florida State is legitimate. They're the No. 1 team and they deserve it. I'm sure they'll be playing for it all year. The only team I've faced that may have been better was in 1986 when Miami beat us 51-7. This team's good. They have talent and they also have the Charlie Ward dimension. A player like him doesn't come along often. He's a great player who adds a different dimension to the game.

"Based on this game, I really can't say how good they are or how bad we are. When you factor in the speed difference, it's very difficult to get a gauge. The two missed scores in the first half hurt us. I thought the defense hung in, we got some turnovers but couldn't take advantage. "

Notes: This was the second worst margin of defeat in Clemson history, the worst since 1931 when Alabama defeated Clemson 74-7. It was the worst ACC loss in Clemson history.....Terry Smith had 8-156 in receiving....he went over the 2,000-yard mark and his reception yardage total was the third highest in Clemson history....the record is 163 by Jerry Butler vs. Georgia Tech in 1977...when Florida State scored a TD on a blocked punt, it was the first blocked punt for a TD against Clemson since 1986...Clemson was shutout for the first time in 162 games dating back to a 19-0 loss to Maryland in 1979...Clemson was last shutout on the road in 1978, at Georgia (12-0)...

Clemson QB Patrick Sapp:

"I knew coming in that I'd get hit a lot. We expected a tough game, but the mistakes we made were hard to overcome. They kept coming with a lot of blitzes. Sometimes you're able to pick 'em up and sometimes you're not. Today it worked for them. We made too many mistakes, and FSU is just too good. I don't think we're a sorry team. They are just loaded with talent.

Clemson WR Jason Davis:

"We came here with a good attitude. When we came out in pregame none of our players were down. We came out and felt good. It's just we were playing the No. 1 team and they played like it. They're well-coached and they're the best team I've ever played against on the field. They're fundamentally sound and don't beat themselves. They're No. 1 and today they proved why they deserve it. Overall they're a good team and championship teams don't beat themselves.
