FIRST HALF

INT FOR PAT

Sophomore Pat Watkins recorded his third interception of the season in today's first quarter. The free safety leads the team with three of FSU's six interceptions.

IN THE HOUSE

Today's attendance is 84,336 – a new Doak Campbell Stadium record. The previous record was 84,106 set in last year's <u>Notre Dame</u> game.

FIRST HALF SHUTOUT

The Seminoles were shutout in the first half of the Georgia Tech game this season only to come back for the 14-13 victory. The last time FSU was shutout in the first half by Miami was in the 2000 season. FSU trailed 17-0 at the half, outscored the Canes 24-10 in the second half and even took a 24-20 lead with 1:37 remaining before falling 27-24. Before that 2000 game, the last time FSU was held scoreless in the first half vs. Miami was on September 3, 1988. No. 1 Florida State trailed 17-0 at the half and lost 31-0.

A SEASON HIGH BY THE HALF

Miami already has more points at halftime than any opponent has scored on the Seminoles in a game this season. Georgia Tech, who also shutout the Seminoles in the first half, scored 13 points – the most of an FSU opponent prior to today's contest.

RAINY DAYS

The last time Florida State was involved in a "rain" game was last season at Louisiville on September 26, 2002. The Seminoles fell 26-20 in their first and only overtime game.

TURNOVERS

Prior to today's game, the Seminoles have turned the ball over a total of two times in the first half (Georgia Tech – fumble; Maryland – interception). In today's first half, the Seminoles have suffered three fumbles (two lost) and thrown two interceptions.

FSU Running Back Greg Jones:

LARGE DEFICIT

The last time FSU trailed by 19 or more points at halftime in a game was on November 25, 1995 vs. Florida in Gainesville. The Seminoles trailed 28-6 at the half, outscored the Gators 18-7 in the third quarter and lost 35-24. The last time FSU trailed by 19 or more points at halftime in a home game was on November 26, 1994 vs. Florida when the Seminoles trailed 24-3 at half, 31-3 after three and scored 28 points in the final 12:59 of the game to force a 31-31 final.

RIX MOVES UP

With today's performance, Rix ...

...moved into 5th place and ahead of Charlie Ward on FSU's all-time passing yardage list with 5,941 yards.

...passed Thad Busby and moved into fifth place with 47 career touchdowns.

FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

On turnovers:

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"What I told the kids all this week was that what will win the game are turnovers and the kicking game. We turned the ball over five times and had a punt blocked. That's your story right there. The statistics were very even so if you want to tell it like it is, the game came down to turnovers and the kicking game. As much as we talked about taking care of the ball, we turned it over too much."

On the weather:

"They handled it so much better than we did. It was a lot like the Louisville game last year as far as the weather is concerned and they handled it better than us. You have to tip your cap to Miami."

"They wouldn't give us north south and the rain took away east west. It's tough to run wide on a muddy field."

"I don't know if he'll (Rix) ever be able to adjust to the rain. Remember he struggled up at Louisville. The footing was better up there, but it rained harder."

On Sean Taylor:

"It was obvious that we could not throw long. You can't hang the ball up for No. 26 (Taylor). I haven't seen a safety that good in a long time. He his as hard as well as he covers."

On bouncing back:

"We've been beaten before. You got no way to respond than to go in and fix your mistakes. We lost to Virginia in 1998 when we were No. 1 in the country, but then we won the rest of our games. It's part of football, you have to adjust."

Momentum change in first half:

"The game changed when we kicked off to them, stopped them and then they punted to us. We didn't do anything so we punted and they gained 30 yards. You have to give their coverage team's credit."

INDIVIDUAL PLAYER NOTES

MIAMI ADDS TO NON-OFFENSIVE SCORING TOTALS

With Sean Taylor's 50-yard interception return for a touchdown, Miami has scored eight touchdowns this season via non-offensive means (special teams or defense) and one safety. The Hurricanes have scored at least one non-offensive touchdown in five of their six games this season, scoring 50 points through non-offensive means in 2003. In 2002, the Hurricanes had six non-offensive scores. For the second straight season in 2001, Miami led the nation in non-offensive scoring with 11 touchdowns and one safety. The 11 scores and one safety gave UM 68 points. The Hurricanes led the nation in 2000 with 13 touchdowns and 89 points coming from defense and special teams.

MIAMI PITCHES FIRST-HALF SHUTOUT

The Hurricanes held FSU scoreless in the first half of the game, the second time in the last four meetings with the Seminoles that UM had shut them out in the first half. Since the start of the 1988 season, FSU has been shut out in the first half only four times (three times vs. UM): today, vs. Georgia Tech (14-13 FSU win) earlier this season, in 2000 vs. Miami (27-24 UM win) and in 1988 vs. the Hurricanes (31-0 UM win).

OTHER FIRST HALF NOTES

Miami's 19 first-half points is the most allowed by FSU in the first half this season...Miami forced five FSU turnovers (three fumbles, two interceptions) in the first half. Prior to this game, FSU had only two first-half turnovers all season...the crowd of 84,336 is a Doak Campbell Stadium record.

GAME CAPTAINS & OPENING COIN TOSS

Miami game captains were Jonathan Vilma, Vince Wilfork, Chris Myers and Kevin Beard. FSU won the toss and deferred selection to the second half. Miami then chose to receive the opening kickoff.

PEATTIE HAS ANOTHER BIG DAY

Freshman placekicker Jon Peattie was successful on three of four field goal attempts today, giving him 13 field goals this season in 15 attempts. The 13 field goals made ranks 10th on the UM single-season list.

PEATTIE'S FIELD GOAL STREAK ENDS AT 10

Freshman placekicker Jon Peattie missed a 23-yard field goal attempt with 8:20 left in the first period today, ending a streak of 10 consecutive successful field goal attempts. That 10-kick streak ranks third in UM history for consecutive attempts made behind the school record of 13 set by Dane Prewitt in 1994 and 11 by Carlos Huerta set over the course of the 1989-90 seasons.

PUNT BLOCK BY MIAMI

The Hurricanes produced their first punt block of the season when senior Jarrell Weaver block an FSU punt to set up the Hurricanes at the FSU 15 in the first period. That block was the first punt block by Miami since Quadtrine Hill's block of a Virginia Tech punt on Dec. 7, 2002, in Miami's 56-45 win over the Hokies.

SPECIAL SPECIAL TEAMS

The Miami special teams played a huge role in Miami's first two scores of the game, blocking a punt to set up UM's first field goal and setting up the offense in FSU territory on the ensuing kickoff when Darnell Jenkins caught Brian Monroe's pooch kick in FSU territory for the second score of the game and a 6-0 Miami lead.

ATKINS FORCES FUMBLE

Redshirt freshman DE Baraka Atkins forced a fumble by FSU tailback Lorenzo Booker in the first quarter that junior DT Vince Wilfork recovered to set up Miami at the the FSU 29. Miami failed to capitalize as Brock Berlin's pass for Roscoe Parrish on the ensuing play was intercepted.

TAYLOR GETS 2 PICKS - INCLUDING A PICK 6

Junior safety Sean Taylor intercepted two passes in the first half against FSU, scoring on a 50-yard return on the second theft to give Miami a 19-0 lead with 3:11 left in the second quarter. Taylor picked off a Chris Rix pass on the first play of the second quarter to end an FSU drive in Miami territory. The thefts were Taylor's fifth and sixth picks this season and his ninth and tenth as a Hurricane. The six this season ranks him tied for ninth in UM annals for a single season and his 10 for a career ranks tied for 10th in Miami history. The touchdown was Taylor's fourth touchdown as a Hurricane, his second on an interception return (both this sason; previous vs. Boston College).

PAYTON'S FIRST TD CATCH AS A HURRICANE

Jarrett Payton took a screen pass from Brock Berlin for 14 yards and a touchdown to give Miami a 12-0 lead with 11:26 remaining in the second quarter. The scoring catch by Payton was the first of his Miami career.

MORE PAYTON NOTES

Senior tailback Jarrett Payton made his first start against FSU...Payton set a new career high for carries. His previous high was 22 last week against West Virginia...Payton also rushed for a career high in the games

"This is a team win for us. Offense, defense and special teams. Nobody had run the ball against Florida Sate and Jarrett Payton really stepped up. Our offensive line really stepped up and we did a nice job running the ball today in some very tough conditions. I think that is probably the difference in the game. I think Jarrett had almost 100 yards and I think their team had about 60. I think that pretty much says it all right there. Offense, defense and special teams just all played extremely well.

"Sean Taylor had a phenomenal game obviously on defense and without question our best defensive game of the year.

"It was a phenomenal job by our scout team throughout the course of the week to give us a great look and prepare us for a tough opponent like Florida State. I would like to compliment them; they have got great athletes. It's almost like playing against yourself. Tough day. Tough conditions. We turned the ball over some and we probably won the turnover battle by some. (John) Peattie came in and did a great job with field goals.

"Randy Shannon and our defensive staff did a tremendous job of studying them and really trying to put them in bad situations. We really stopped the run, which allowed to really do the other part of the things we needed to do to really put them into tough situations and that really helped us.

"I think this was a great effort by the preparation our coaches put in and the response that our team had. We came in here not on a high note. We had taken a lot of criticism, even though we won, from a close loss. Not a lot of people actually gave us much of a chance to win this game. It just says a lot about our character.

When you beat a Florida State or a Florida you have done something. They are a marquee team and they have been for years. To win this game is a great – a litmus test about where we are. In reality, it's our sixth win and we are bowl eligible. We have got a lot of tough football teams left to play. I've seen a glimpse of what I knew we had, and we talked about it as an offensive staff and a defensive staff, and we knew that we were better at times that what we have played. We have seen a glimpse of what we can be and now we have to build on that."
